



## Spring Seabeck Rules for Families, Teens, and Children at Seabeck

**Parents:** You are responsible for your children at all times while at Seabeck. Please sit down with your child before camp and review the rules below. It may help if both you and your child initial these in agreement. Our late-night policy requires that parents not allow their children out after 10:00 pm unless an adult has agreed to supervise them. **No exceptions!** Remember to sign your child(ren) in at the children's program, pick them up promptly, and remind them that they must check in and out with you all weekend. The adults in charge of the children's and teen's programs are not responsible for your children outside of the scheduled program times.

### Spring Seabeck Retreat Rules:

Travel in groups of three whenever possible.

Respect all people and property.

Think – Keep your actions safe.

Be sure to wear shoes at the beach.

Electronic devices are not a part of our camp activities.

Always have an adult with you if you leave the grounds.

Follow all Seabeck rules and procedures (See below).

### Seabeck Conference Center Rules and Procedures:

Children must have a supervising adult for any and all water activities.

Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades/skates are not allowed on the grounds.

Adults must supervise young children at all times on the playground equipment.

Report maintenance needs to Seabeck office as soon as possible.

Vehicles allowed only on roads and designated parking areas. No RVs.

No pets allowed at Seabeck.

Do not bring snacks into sleeping areas.

Smoking allowed only in designated areas.

Alcohol must be stored in a locked car.
